
LET'S TALK ABOUT HEALTH: Mhat Every Woman Should Know

The Film

Hosted by former WNBC Morning News anchor Jane Hanson, "Let's Talk About Health" is a 30-minute educational film produced in the early 1990's by The Arc of New Jersey that brings viewers step-by-step through a gynecological examination, including a mammogram and pelvic examination. The film is very explicit, providing clear explanation of procedures, and also includes comments made by a focus group of women with developmental disabilities.
