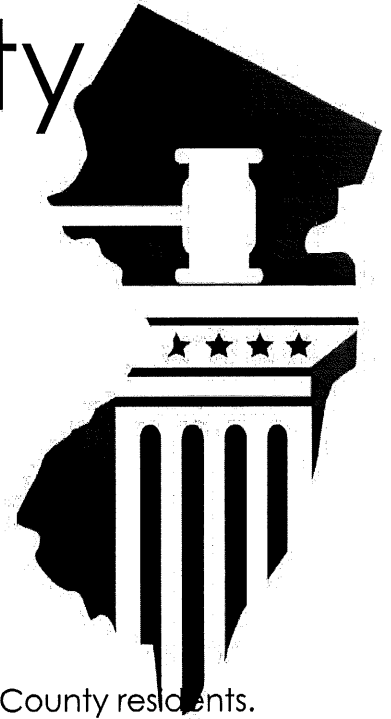

FREE INFORMATION SESSIONS:

Court Night is an evening of FREE information sessions open to Middlesex County residents.

The sessions will provide practical information and resource material to help residents navigate the court system. Attorneys and court representatives will conduct the sessions and will be available to answer general questions from the public about each subject.

- **Immigration:** Find out the latest on current law, deportation and consequences related to criminal and municipal court convictions.
- **Landlord/Tenant:** Learn about your rights as a landlord or tenant. This session will discuss the basics of landlord/tenant court.
- **Child Support:** This session will cover the basics of filing for child support as well as modifications and termination.
- **Domestic Violence:** Learn about prevention, resources and support assistance for victims.

Food will be provided at no charge during the program and child care will be available.
