**IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION**

February 16, 2015

Dear DDD Consumer:

Effective January 22, 2013, the eligibility regulations for the Division of Developmental Disabilities (Division) were changed to require Medicaid eligibility as a condition to receive Division funded services.

Our current records indicate that you are not receiving a Division funded service and you are not enrolled on Medicaid. As such, your file with the Division will be closed on March 31, 2015.

In the future, if you become Medicaid eligible and wish to obtain Division services, please contact a Division regional office and request to speak to an intake worker for your County. This link will assist you: <http://www.state.nj.us/humanservices/ddd/services/apply/>
